Autumn Term

We are very excited to begin our learning in year 3! This term we will be learning all about the Prehistoric World! We will become historians, travelling back in time through the Stone Age and Bronze Age before visiting the Iron Age.

Reading

Developing our fluency and word reading, alongside our comprehension skills.

We will be reading picture books based on our history topic, before reading Planet Omar: Accidental Trouble Magnet

Writing

Grammar – nouns and verbs, sentence construction.

Narrative and setting descriptions based on Stone Age Boy

Maths

Place value and number within 1000
Addition and subtraction

Science

Rocks – different types of rocks, how fossils are formed, how soils are formed.

Animals, including Humans – nutrition

Physical Education

Indoor (Monday): Bootcamp, developing knowledge of fitness and applying it to circuit training.

Outdoor (Tuesday): Multi-Skills, developing fundamental skills such as balancing and co-ordination.

Music

Developing notation and the understanding of four beats in a bar through song.
