



Year 4

Autumn Term

We are very excited about the learning in Year 4 this year! We will be learning lots of new things, as well as repeated practice for the skills we have already learnt. We will be transported this term to Ancient Greece for our history and we be working hard on our times tables all year.

Reading

We will be continuing to use Destination Reader within our guided reading, learning how to use reading behaviours effectively and read with purpose and understanding. Our first text is: 'Beasts of Olympus – Beast Keeper'.

Writing

Grammar as place value, looking at nouns and verbs and applying this to sentence writing. We will then move on to writing Theseus and the Minotaur, after learning it off by heart.

Maths

We start the year with place value and securing numbers within 1000 and then up to 10,000. We will then move on to addition and subtraction. We will also have daily Number Sense Times Tables lessons and Mastering Number.

Science

We begin Year 4 with learning about teeth and the digestive system. We will then move on to learning about and making circuits for electricity. We will be applying our learning through investigations and experiments.

Physical Education

Our PE this term is: 'Boot Camp' and 'Invaders'.
