Reading

We will be using Destination Reader within our guided reading, learning how to use reading behaviours effectively and read with purpose and understanding. Our first text is Piq Heart Boy, followed by Nowhere Emporium.

<u>Science</u>

We will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn to classify them into different species by using their characteristics. We will then move on to the circulatory system, learning about the human body and how it works.

Art/ DT

This term, we will be using mechanical structures to create a mechanical toy. In art we will be looking at

2D to 3D sculptures and will create an animal using these skills.

Writing

We will start the term with a Grammar focus identifying different types of nouns and verbs and applying them to our writing. We will move onto writing non chronological reports about mythical creatures.
