1	Self Portraits Each child to complete a self-portrait using media suitable for their year group. To be kept in art folders and taken to next year group.	Drawing & Sketchbooks: Spirals Using spirals as inspiration, children explore mark making through tools and their bodies.		Colour & Surface: Flora & Fauna Through pen, pastel, charcoal and collage children explore plants, flowers and insects. 2		Drawing & Sketchbooks: Explore & Draw Children become collectors, bringing things back into the classroom to inspire their art.		Colour & Surface: Expressive Painting Children explore primary colours and secondary colours through expressive mark making, connecting colour, mark making and texture or paint through abstract work.		Working in 3D: Be an Architect Children explore architecture around them and create their own architectural models.

Colour & Surface: Exploring Still Life Using collage, photography, paint and clay to create an observational drawing of physical objects.		Working in 3D: The Art of Display Children think carefully not just about what they make, but also how they present what they make.

Colour & Surface: Mixed Media & Cityscapes Children go into the world and draw and paint from life, inspired by the land and cityscapes where they live.
